

Notice on Banning Motorcycles, Tooting and Speeding on Campus

At USTC, there have been scenes of motorcycles roaring past, speeding of motor vehicles, and willful tooting. Such uncivil behaviors, occurring from time to time, have undermined peace and harmony of the campus and threatened the safety of pedestrians, leading to complaints by faculties. To safeguard the safety of faculties and to create a barrier-free, green and peaceful campus, USTC decides to strengthen traffic regulation starting from June 1, with reference to "Law of The People's Republic of China on Road Traffic Safety ", "Regulations on the Implementation of the Road Traffic Safety Law of the People's Republic of China" and "Regulations on Road Traffic Safety of Hefei". The relevant rules are as follows:

1. All kinds of motorcycles, fuel-powered mopeds, and unlicensed closed-type electric vehicles are strictly prohibited from entering the campus. Owners are required to remove the vehicles from the campus.
2. Civil behaviors and reasonable care are required when driving motor vehicles on campus. Motor vehicles should let pedestrians go first and tooting is prohibited.

3. The speed of all kinds of vehicles on campus must not exceed 20km/h.

4. For motor vehicles going against the rules above, the Security and Campus Management Office will handle violations in accordance with the law.

5. Faculties are welcome to identify and report various uncivil driving behaviors on campus. The reporting line is 63600110.

The rules are hereby announced with the notice.
